Stephany M. Barrera

Born and raised in South Los Angeles in a Mexican/Nicaraguan low-income household, Stephany became the first in her family to attend and graduate from college. As a first-generation, queer woman of color, she faced many obstacles and struggled throughout her academic journey. As a response to financial hardship and her commitment to students, she worked multiple jobs to finance her education.

Within these roles, she provided direct support to students of color by teaching college seminars, advising students 1:1, mentoring students, organizing admit weekends and Latinx graduations, facilitated workshops on diversity, equity, and inclusion to students, and advocated for student needs in access and retention. Her contributions on campus led to policy changes regarding better student working conditions, administrative transparency and accountability, and more funding toward student retention services.
